Cathy Flavin is the Deputy Project Director of the Uranium Processing Facility Project (UPF), a \$6.5 billion facility that will replace WWII-era production facilities at the Y-12 National Security Complex in Oak Ridge, Tennessee.

Cathy has held a variety of engineering and leadership roles during her 29-year career. Prior to being named the Deputy Project Director at UPF in 2018, she was the Manager of Engineering for the project, and led a team of more than 1,000 engineers. She joined the UPF Project in 2014.
